Secondments

Esen ÇAKIR, Associate from KDK sharing her experience about secondment at Jeantet



"I completed a three-month secondment in Paris, where I joined Jeantet's Arbitration and Energy Law department, led by Thierry Lauriol, who is also President of ELG. What made the experience particularly interesting was that I was stepping outside competition law, which is my usual field of practice. Adapting to unfamiliar subject matter was initially demanding, but it quickly became the most rewarding part early on, which helped me learn fast and feel genuinely involved.

My colleagues were incredibly warm and welcoming and went out of their way to make sure I understood the matters we were working on. I am especially grateful for the delicious lunch spots they introduced me to and for their enthusiasm for the profession, which was truly inspiring.

Advantages and challenges of the secondment

One of the key advantages of my secondment was that it took place in Paris, a city I already knew well as the city of my alma mater. Having close friends there also made the transition much easier and helped me navigate any practical challenges of living abroad. Another major advantage was being able to work in French, a language in which I was already professionally proficient. Also, my team in Jeantet was international and culturally diverse, which made day-to-day collaboration all the more enriching.

The main challenge was the shift in practice area itself. Competition law and international arbitration require quite different instincts, and the learning curve was steep at first. But the team was very supportive, and looking back, working outside my comfort zone gave me a broader perspective on legal practice that I would not have gained otherwise.

Would you recommend other members to go for a secondment somewhere?

Absolutely. I would strongly recommend a secondment to anyone who has the opportunity. It is a unique chance to experience a different professional culture, develop new legal skills, and build meaningful relationships with new colleagues. I also had the opportunity to give a presentation about investment opportunities in Turkey, as well as about KDK, which allowed me to share a bit of my

own background with the team. I can particularly recommend Jeantet, where the team went above and beyond to make me feel included and to involve me in meaningful work throughout my stay. I am deeply grateful to have had the chance to be a part of this experience, and I sincerely thank my colleagues in both Paris and Istanbul for placing their trust in me."
