# Secondments

“I was seconded from Gorrissen Federspiel to Uría Menéndez in Madrid from January through March 2026 (approximately three months). During my stay, I joined the Energy and Natural Resources team, working closely with partners Juan Ignacio González and Ignacio Álvarez.

My secondment was a very rewarding experience. From the outset, I was warmly welcomed by the team and quickly felt integrated into both the professional and social environment. I had the opportunity to work on a variety of interesting matters and gained valuable insight into the Spanish legal framework and market practices within the energy sector.

## **Advantages and challenges of the secondment**




One of the main advantages of the secondment was the exposure to a different legal system and way of working, which broadened my perspective on cross-border matters. It also allowed me to build strong relationships with colleagues in another jurisdiction – both within Uría Menéndez and with other secondees at the firm – which I believe will be valuable going forward.

Despite working in a different jurisdiction, I was pleasantly surprised by how closely aligned Gorrissen Federspiel and Uría Menéndez are in terms of values, professionalism, and expectations to quality. This made the transition very smooth and allowed me to integrate quickly from an early stage.
